We recognize that a healthy planet is essential to the health and well-being of people and communities, and we are committed to integrating environmental considerations into our operations, decision-making, and stakeholder engagement.

This policy supports our broader Environmental, Social, and Governance (“ESG”) strategy and serves as a practical guide for all employees and partners.

2. Scope

This policy applies to all Certara employees, officers, and directors globally.

Where applicable, we extend our environmental expectations to suppliers, contractors, and business partners. We encourage them to adopt sustainable practices aligned with our principles and to collaborate with us on shared environmental goals.

As we grow and develop our ESG strategy, we may expand the scope and impact of this policy. We are committed to transparency, continuous improvement, and reporting our progress to stakeholders.

Certara recognizes the importance of leading by example, as well as the power of demonstrating the start and progression of incremental and sustained progress, while sharing these milestones and commitments with our stakeholders and encouraging participation across our global network.

3. Core Principles and Commitments

In line with our environmental goals, Certara seeks to integrate and promote sustainability principles across our business activities and operations. Our core environmental commitments include:

- **Environmental Management & Climate Action:**
 - We are committed to developing and maintaining programs that promote awareness, measurement, and proactive management of our environmental impacts.
 - This includes measuring and transparently reporting our greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions –including Scope 1, Scope 2, and Scope 3 categories-- through our annual ESG Report.

- Our ESG Report, our community and the larger public to track our year-over-year performance and actions against stated environmental goals.
 - We strive to reduce our environmental footprint where feasible, focusing on operational efficiencies, energy conservation and sustainable practices.
 - We support the integration of climate-related opportunities into our business strategy and decision-making processes.
 - We have committed to developing science-based targets (“SBTi”) for GHG emission reduction through the STBi. Once approved, our targets and progress will be subject to independent validation and review.
- **Resource Efficiency and Waste Management:**
 - We promote the efficient use of resources, including energy and water, particularly in our office environments and data center operations.
 - We encourage waste reduction through practices such as minimizing consumption, promoting two-sided printing and copying, supporting recycling initiatives, and ensuring the responsible disposal of materials--aiming to apply principles of a circular economy where practical.
 - When selecting new office space, we give preferences to facilities that demonstrate sustainable building practices and offer environmentally responsible tenant resources, where feasible and appropriate.
- **Legal and Regulatory Compliance:**
 - We commit to full compliance with all applicable environmental laws, regulations, and standards in the jurisdictions where we operate.
- **Sustainable Procurement and Supply Chain:**
 - We recognize that a significant portion of our environmental and social impact lies within our value chain.
 - We expect our key suppliers, contractors, and business partners to uphold high standards of ethical conduct, environmental stewardship, and respect for human rights--standards that align with our Code of Conduct and ESG principles.
 - In support of our commitment to continuous improvement, we may give preference to suppliers who demonstrate progress on material sustainability topics. We utilize a risk-based approach to assess and encourage responsible environmental and social practices throughout our supply chain.
 - With the guidance of subject matter experts, we are working toward more comprehensive and actionable supply chain sustainability strategy--one that identifies and supports opportunities for environmental performance improvements, where relevant and feasible.
- **Stakeholder Engagement and Transparency:**
 - We continue to model transparency regarding our environmental performance and initiatives, primarily through our annual ESG Report.

- We engage with relevant stakeholders, including investors, employees, clients, and industry partners, to understand expectations and share progress.
- We participate in relevant industry assessment processes (like EcoVadis and CDP disclosures, among others) to benchmark our performance and identify areas for improvement.
- We have made a public company-commitment to submit a GHG emissions reduction plan under the SBTi program.
- **Continuous Improvement:**
 - We view sustainability as an ongoing journey and are committed to continuously reviewing and improving our environmental performance, programs, and practices.
 - We actively monitor best practices, technologies, and evolving regulatory requirements relevant to our operations and industry.
 - We provide annual training to employees on our values, business principles including topics foundational to our ESG strategy, Such as environmental responsibility, ethical conduct and responsible business practices.

4. Responsibilities

- **Leadership:** Certara's executive leadership team, under the oversight by the Board of Directors and its committees, are responsible for championing this policy, integrating environmental considerations into business planning and overseeing its effective implementation.
